

Fire Destroys Watford City Salt Water Disposal Facility

White Owl Energy Services Inc. (“White Owl” or the “Company”) announces at approximately 11:15 a.m. CST, Thursday January 17, 2019 an explosion occurred on a saltwater disposal site owned by White Owl within the city limits of Watford City, North Dakota. The facility was totally destroyed in the ensuing fire. There were no injuries as a result of the fire. The local fire department extinguished the fire by early evening that same day.

Once the Company was advised of the incident the corporate Emergency Response Plan (“ERP”) was activated and White Owl personnel co-ordinated with area first responders, city and county officials and regulators to ensure the safety of area residents and company personnel near the impacted zone. The Company continues to cooperate with the appropriate authorities.

White Owl’s management is investigating along with the local fire department and the insurance adjuster the cause of the fire. The Company has property insurance to cover the costs to rebuild the facility as well as business interruption insurance for the loss of income over the reconstruction period which is estimated to be approximately five months.
